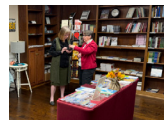

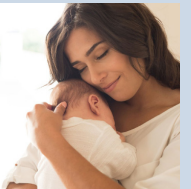
JUNIOR CAMP AT COLONIAL
