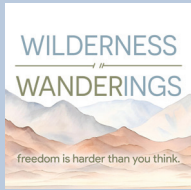

### CHOIR MEMBERSHIP WINDOW IS OPEN

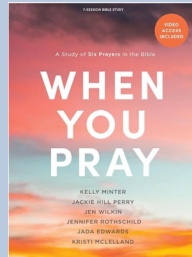
