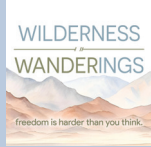




HELPING OUR NEIGHBORS

Volunteers are needed to help flood victims south of our church. Please sign up at the Welcome Center or through the Registration QR code.

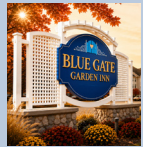


SMALL GROUPS

November 6-7

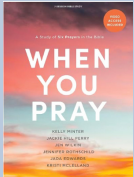
Join us for our Couples Retreat at the Blue Gate Garden Inn in Shipshewana, IN. Our guest speakers are Mark and Amy Herbster.
